

Discussion Summary

- Update on fast-track progress.
- Committee discussed whether the reapproval process for fast track courses should begin in fall 2014 or fall 2015.
- Core Curriculum policy statement was reviewed by committee members.
- The opportunity for a combination of courses to meet multiple learning outcomes was discussed.
- The committee discussed First Year Seminar courses and the KU Core.

Decisions and Action Items

- The first set of fast tracked courses should be available for review by UCCC subcommittees by 9/26/12.
 - Subcommittees should review the courses proposed prior to the next UCCC meeting.
- The policy guiding Opt-in/Opt-out options for the KU Core portions was discussed and the following recommendations were developed:
 - Current students will be allowed to opt-in to the KU Core requirements, but must do so during the 2014 academic year (i.e., before fall 2014).
 - Transfer students will be allowed to opt-out if they enter KU between fall 2013 and fall 2015.
 - Readmitted students will be required to follow the readmit process for the appropriate school/college.
- UCCC unanimously passed the approval of the number 177 to designate all First Year Seminar courses. Each department will have a XXXX 177 course that they may (or may not) use to offer a first year seminar.
